#### INFORMATION SHEET

Welcome to the 25<sup>th</sup> Annual Summer Festival sponsored by the Washington/Beaufort County Chamber of Commerce by the beautiful Pamlico River (Stewart Parkway) in downtown Washington, North Carolina. The festival has approximately 90 vendors and exhibitors. Please note that space is limited as we have cut back on the number of vendors this year. Look for our new format. We are seeking more Arts/Craft vendors this year. Commercial items will be limited.

All booth spaces are assigned on a first-come, first-serve basis. Festival confirmation information will be mailed by May, 2008.

Money is non-refundable.

Spaces must remain clean at all times. T-shirt sales of any kind will not be allowed, as the “Summer Festival T-Shirt” sales is a revenue source for the Chamber. Any vendors that do not adhere to the policies of the Washington/Beaufort County Chamber of Commerce will be asked to leave.

Food Vendors can begin set-up on Friday, June 13<sup>th</sup> at 8:00am and must be completed by 11:00am for B.C. Health & Fire Department inspections. There are Fire/Health regulations for food being cooked under tents. Your application must state if you are cooking under a tent or self-contained trailer/unit.

Arts/Craft and Information vendors can begin set-up on Friday, June 13<sup>th</sup> at 10.00am. Vendors/Exhibitors will not be allowed in the park area to set up after the Festival begins and will not be allowed to break down until the Festival is over (10:00pm Saturday night).

All Vendors/Exhibitors MUST CHECK IN AT THE CHAMBER REGISTRATION TENT to get your parking pass and information packets (located in front of the Chamber office) before you can begin set up.
