At 4:30PM on Saturday, March 14, 2020, our worlds flipped upside-down in Beaufort County Schools with Governor Cooper's Executive Order #117 which immediately closed all schools for students. Unfortunately, there was no forecast that Friday, March 13, 2020 would be the last day that students and teachers would be able to interact and embrace with hugs, handshakes, high-fives, fist-bumps, and belly-aching laughter. It was quite surreal walking through school hallways and classrooms that reflected so much teaching, learning, love, and momentum yet suddenly my shoes were the only echoes ping-ponging down the hallways on that early Sunday morning. Lesson plans and classroom materials lay in place ready for students to embrace the academic, social, and emotional challenges of another promising Monday and week of school. Our teachers and staff were ready and prepared for the new week before a new normal grew spontaneously within our district, county, region, and state. COVID-19 and the school closures changed all of us.

The necessity for immediate change was so spectacular with such a demand of urgency that the conglomerate of stakeholders responded above and beyond the call for help. I am writing to you, the Beaufort County Schools employees, the family members, the community leaders, the business partners, and the hundreds of others who helped us maintain teaching and learning for our students from March 16th to the final high school graduation ceremony. I am writing to YOU as a measure to say THANK YOU. To our parents and families who became overnight teachers, to our teachers who became overnight Zoom experts as they entered into your homes and workplaces, to the school nutrition teams who prepared meals nearly every single day for our students whether rain or shine, to our local community leaders and business partners who simply asked how you could help, THANK YOU.

As you know, the 2019-2020 school year has concluded. However, the 2020-2021 school year begins on Monday, August 17, 2020 with new recommendations and requirements that will follow suit to ensure the safety and wellness of our students, employees, and community. Beaufort County Schools will continue to follow the guidance of Governor Cooper, the Department of Health and Human Services, and the State Board of Education regarding re-entry plans for the new school year. As summer progresses, please anticipate greater information to follow regarding how Beaufort County Schools shall operate. On behalf of the Beaufort County Board of Education, THANK YOU for supporting our students and schools as we continue to take comfort in the care that you generously provide every single day.

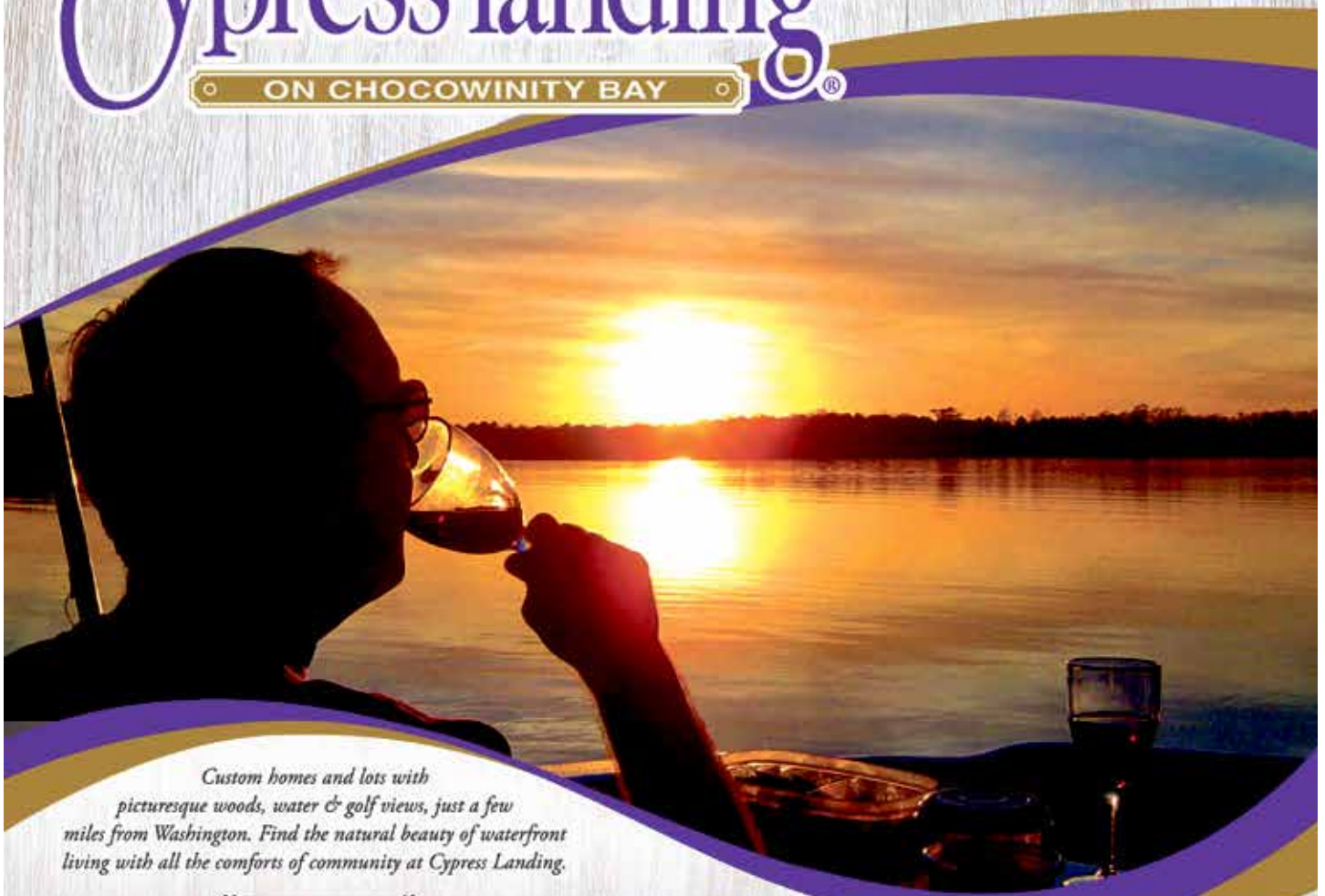

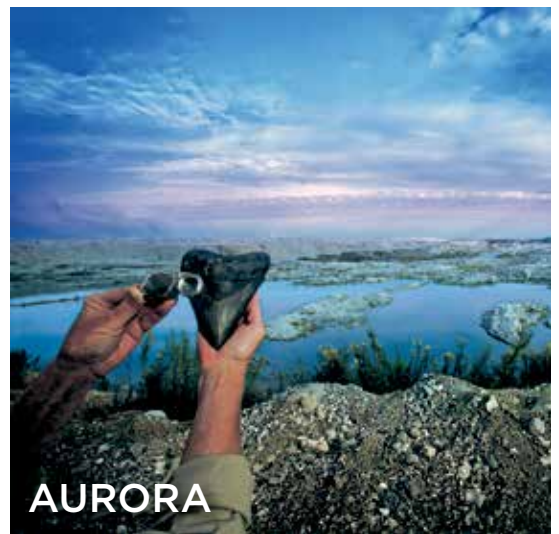
BATH

The Aurora Fossil Museum, located in town, includes a wide variety of marine fossils from the Pleistocene, Pliocene and Miocene eras, as well as Native American artifacts from the area.
- For lunch, savor a shrimp basket and a piece of lemon meringue pie from a nearby restaurant.

- Stay at a local motel or airbnb. In the morning, head over to Cypress Landing to experience golf at its finest, a warm and welcoming environment. Enjoy a delicious lunch at a local eatery.
- For afternoon entertainment, try your hand at a friendly game of paintball or have fun at the local skating rink. For dinner, delicious Asian cuisine, or some down home country cookin' from a local deli.

In town, there's a community park; just out of town, there's Terra Ceia Farms, world-famous for its tulip and peony bulbs that bloom in the spring.

Aurora Fossil Museum

Located in the town of Aurora, the Aurora Fossil Museum showcases 5- to 15-million-year-old marine fossils from the nearby Nutrien phosphate mine and Native American artifacts from across prehistoric North Carolina. The museum's mission to increase knowledge of the geology, paleontology and prehistory of coastal North Carolina is achieved through exhibits, interactive activities, outreach programs, events, field studies and the annual Fossil Festival. Children can dig for their own fossils, including sharks' teeth, at the fossil pit located across the street from the museum. Open Mondays through Saturdays from 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., and Sundays, from 12:30 p.m. to 4 p.m. (from March 1 through Labor Day).



Belhaven Memorial Museum

This eclectic historic collection of Mrs. Eva Blount Way features many pieces of eastern North Carolina's past — Civil War and World War I uniforms, records, 19th-century clothing, old farming equipment and more. Open from 1 p.m. to 5 p.m. daily, except for Wednesdays.

Historic Port of Washington Project

HPOW has displays set up in the Harbor District Farmers & Artisans Market, open Wednesdays through Fridays, from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m., and Saturdays, from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Fauna and flora like nowhere else exist in the estuaries, where fresh and saltwater converge as rivers travel east to the Atlantic Ocean. On free pontoon boat rides, guests can see the estuary in person, as well as take part in educational pro-

Located in a restored Seaboard Coast Line Railroad caboose, a relic of Washington's past, the museum is open Thursdays and Fridays, from 11 a.m. to 5 p.m., and Sundays, from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Washington Waterfront Underground Railroad Museum also has displays set up in the Harbor District Farmers & Artisans Market, open Thursdays and Fridays, from 11 a.m. to 5 p.m., and Sundays, from 2 p.m. to 5 p.m.

Can you find them all?

The 'Crabs on the Move' project started in 2006. The Pine Needles Garden Club started this venture as a way to give back to the community in Washington. The crab statues were auctioned off to different organizations and businesses at a 'Crab Ball,' a black tie event that was held at the Washington Civic Center. The money raised went to local charities. The crabs were painted and decorated by local artists, then displayed in town. At that time, the statues would be moved to different parts of town on occasion. Thus the 'Crabs on the Move' became the name of the initiative.

Project objectives included providing a marketing tool for tourism, raising money for local charities, tying in with the Estuarium's existing logo, providing an icon for tourists and locals in which to identify Beaufort County, and bringing Beaufort County's first outdoor art exhibit to life - a showcase for our local artists.

The project eventually took a new direction when they were bought by various businesses, organizations, and individuals, (many were repainted) and were placed in permanent spots throughout Washington and Beaufort County.

Here is a list of the crab statues with locations and photographs for families, individuals and other groups can use as a type of 'scavenger hunt' to find and post your pictures.

We hope you enjoy this activity while social distancing.

If we have missed a crab statue, let us know where it is, and we will add it!

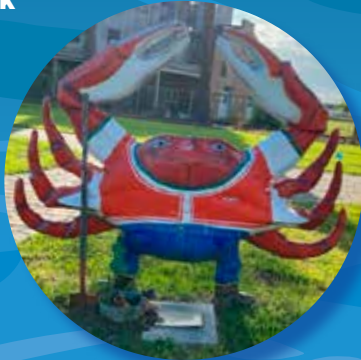

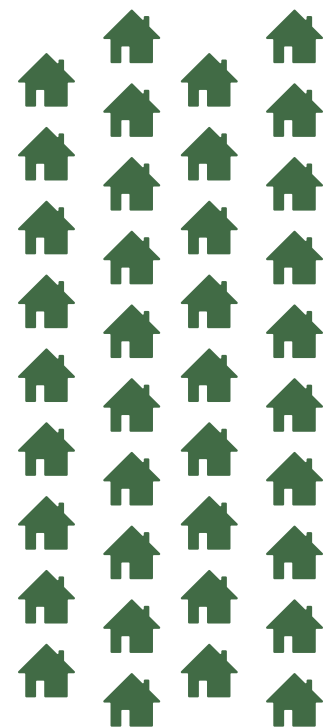

HIGHWAYS

Supporting the movement of people and things, Highway US 264 East/West is a four-lane divided highway that connects Beaufort County to Greenville and beyond to I-95 and I-40.

US 17 North/South is a four lane divided highway through Beaufort County and partially four-lane to parts of Norfolk, VA and Morehead City, NC.

The quickest way to Highway 95 is in Wilson, NC which is 65.4 miles away



PASSENGER AIR

Warren Field is a general aviation, full-service airport operated by the City of Washington. It proudly serves corporate and recreational aviation flying in and out of Beaufort County.

Pitt-Greenville Airport is located 26 minutes from Beaufort County and offers flights via American Airlines to Charlotte Douglas International Airport.

Coastal Carolina Regional Airport in New Bern, NC is located 30 minutes south of Washington and offers flights via American Airlines to Charlotte Douglas International Airport and Delta Airlines to Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport.

Raleigh-Durham International Airport is located 120 minutes from Beaufort County and provides over 400 daily flights via major US carriers with international flights to London, Paris, and Toronto.

WATERWAYS & ICW

The Washington Waterfront is along the north shore of the Pamlico River, approximately 25 nautical miles westerly from the Intracoastal Waterway, and 55 nautical miles from Ocracoke Island.

The channel from Red marker 16 in the Pamlico River has a normal depth of 9 to 11 feet to the Coastal Railway swing bridge. Inside the trestle, water depths run from 14 to 24 feet.



RAIL

Rail service is provided by Norfolk Southern and CSX railroads connecting Beaufort County. Norfolk Southern provides direct access to rail at the Beaufort County Industrial Park at Chocowinity.
