

# 43rd Washington Summer Festival

## 2026 Vendor Information Sheet

- **Festival Hours** are 4pm - 9pm on Friday, June 12th. Fireworks will be shortly after 9pm. Saturday, June 13th hours are 10am - 8pm.
- **Washington Police Department** will be on patrol during festival hours. If you need assistance, please contact one of the officers at the Police/Fire/EMS command station located on Stewart Parkway at Respass Street. If it is an emergency call 911.
- **Washington Fire Department** regulations requires all tents to be secured.
- **Vendors will not be allowed to move out of the festival area on Friday until after the fireworks are over and the crowd has cleared and on Saturday night until the festival has closed AND the police have cleared the area.** There is absolutely **NO DRIVING** on the parkway once you are set up until after the festival closes on Saturday. There is also **NO DRIVING** in and out of reserved parking areas. If you want to park in the reserved parking area with your pass, you must be parked by 3:00pm and you will not be able to leave until the festival is over and the police have cleared the parkway for driving. This is for the safety of pedestrians. If you think you may need to leave during festival hours, you need to park in an alternate location.
- **All electrical services will be disconnected when the festival ends Saturday night.**
- **In the event of bad weather** please use your best judgement. Safety is of the utmost importance. Please make sure your tent/canopy is secured.
- **Food Vendors with gray water:** Please note that grease and gray water containers will be provided (at no charge) and located by the portable out-houses.
- **All Vendors are responsible for the cleaning of their space:** Trash that cannot fit inside standard trash cans provided may not be left onsite. Dumping of any sort is prohibited, including oils, grease, coals, ice, trash, etc. onto streets, grass, sidewalks or drains.
- **No Alcohol or Animals** (except service dogs) will be allowed on the Parkway during festival hours.
- **Festival T-Shirts, Lost & Found and Festival Information Booth** will be located on Stewart Parkway near The Chamber of Commerce. If you need assistance, please contact one of our festival staff.
